

Rose Street Primary School Sports Funding Grant 2016/2017

The primary PE and sport premium 2016 to 2017 ("the premium") will be paid by the Secretary of State for Education ("Secretary of State") to the local authority ("authority"). The authority will then distribute the premium to maintained schools in its area as stated in Section 14 of the Education Act 2002. In accordance with Section 16 of that Act, the Secretary of State lays down the following terms and conditions on which financial assistance is given in relation to the premium payable for the academic year 2016 to 2017.

In our school this will amount to £9,045 and we intend to use it to provide excellent sports opportunities for all pupils. To do this we will use qualified coaches for specific sports, improve confidence amongst staff in the delivery of high quality PE lessons across the school through staff training, transport children to sporting festivals, competitions and events and improve our resources for both indoor and outdoor activities. We feel that this is the most effective and efficient way for the funding to have a long lasting and positive effect on future learning and physical development of children within our school.

How the funding was used:

Equipment and resources.

CPD and curriculum delivery support - observations of specialist coaches for future planning, teaching and learning.

Staff release for festivals and tournaments - Kent School Games/sporting festivals

Specialist coaches for team teaching with staff

Specialist tennis / golf coaching - Summer term

Enrichment activities - Kidz Fit- Olympic Athlete visit

Cycling proficiency- Bikeability and balanceability

IMPACT OF FUNDING:-

1. Greater confidence in planning and delivery of the Physical Education Scheme of Work. Observations of children and staff during PE lessons.

2. Equipment will be used more effectively - observations.

3. Assessment of pupils skills and development in PE, begin to use assessment by teachers and children in PE lessons.

4. Increased after school clubs and participation in PE and sport including more sport opportunities within school.

5. Skilled coaches delivering varied sports - observations.
